Appeal in Guisti Case Denied By High Court

"Carson March 30 - An appeal in the case of Phoebe Guisti against John Guisti has been denied by the state supreme court. Phoebe Guisti was awarded \$3,000 by the Nye county district court for money alleged to have been advanced to John for purchase of a saloon building. This award decision was reversed by the supreme court in 1918 and in the lower court she was allowed to file amended complaint. An appeal was taken from this allowance."

24 Dec 1921

"Tonopah - Judge Emmet Walsh came over from Goldfield Thursday to hear the suit of Mrs. P.L. Guisti vs. John Guisti and took the case under advisement. The suit has been before the supreme court twice and has occupied various judges in the southern district for the past few years without getting any closer to a solution. The case was submitted on the former testimony."

4 Feb 1932

Nye County Matron Is Taken By Death

"Tonopah - Following an attack of illness, Mrs. Phoebe Guisti, aged sixty-four, a resident of Nye County for twenty-seven years, died at the county hospital here yesterday. She is survived by her sister, Mrs. William Sanders of Carlisle, Clinton County, IL, where Mrs. Guisti was born on Jan 9, 1868. The deceased was admitted to the hospital on January 26 of this year. Funeral arrangements have not as yet been made."

Feb 1932

"Tonopah - Former resident of Beatty. Mrs. Guisti was brought to Tonopah from the southern end of the county to be treated for carcinoma. She was buried 10 Feb 1932."

24 Feb 1932 "In the District Court of Nye County letters of administration on the estate of Phoebe Guisti, formerly of Beatty, was granted F.J. Cavanaugh, public administrator."
