Mrs. T. Kendall Dies In Tonopah

"Tonopah - Mrs. Tom Kendall, a resident of Nevada all of her life, died early this morning. She suffered a stroke Saturday morning (4 Nov 1939) and never regained consciousness.

Born in Austin fifty years ago, she spent her early life in that camp and lived for a short time in Bodie. Her family moved to Goldfield where she worked as Chief telephone operator for a time, and later was employed at the John S. Cooke bank. She was married in 1920 to Tom Kendall who died last April. Mr. Kendall was an associate of Tex Rickard in the early days of Tonopah and Goldfield. They made their home in Las Vegas and Tonopah.
