Thomas W. Kendall Dies In Vegas

"Las Vegas - Thomas W. Kendall, 68, prominent Nevada mining man and one of the original discoverers of Goldfield, died early Tuesday at his home here while playing cards with his wife.

Kendall came to Nevada from Bodie, California, in 1891. He had been in poor health for several months. Death was attributed to a heart attack. When he was engaged in mining in the early days at Tonopah, he was associated with George Wingfield.

Later he became one of the original Goldfield discoverers, with the Kendall Mine being the second to be opened in the district. A native of Mariposa County, California, Kendall also had engaged in the hotel and club business in the Nevada boom days.

He leaves his widow and two sons, Robert 17, and Billy, 14. Interment will be in Tonopah."
