Edward J. Reed Rites Held

"Tonopah - Funeral services for Edward John Reed, former Nye County cattleman who died in Tonopah Dec 7 after a long illness, were conducted by Tonopah Elks at the lodge hall here Thursday morning. Several piano solos were rendered by Mrs. M. A. Williams.

Burial was made in the Tonopah Cemetery and casket bearers were Scott Mullins, Bozo Boscovich, Joe Clifford Jr., Tony Antoniazzi, Art Oswald and Ray Lorigan.

Born in Unionville, Dec. 8, 1877, Mr. Reed spent his early life in Humboldt County. In 1905 he went to Gold Reed and engaged in mining until 1907. For many years he was a prominent cattleman in Nye County with his brother, the late O.K. Reed. He had been living at Elko for the last four years. Mr. Reed was a long time member of the Goldfield Elks Lodge.

Surviving is a brother, Kincaid Reed of Elko; a sister, Mrs. Paul Schraps of Vacaville, CA; a brother George Reed of Paradise Valley and a number of nieces and nephews, including Mrs. Edward (Helen) Slavin of Tonopah."
