William Sartin Dies In Tonopah

"Tonopah - A resident of Tonopah for the past seven years, William Henry Sartin, sixty-four year old employee of the Tonopah Club, passed away on Tuesday morning following an extended illness. He was in failing health for the past year, and a few weeks ago entered the Nye County Hospital, where he succumbed.

Funeral services were conducted from the Elks Hall Friday afternoon under the direction of officers of Tonopah Lodge of Elks. The Rev. Basil Daugherty, accompanied by Mrs. C. E. Byrd, sang a vocal number during the services. Burial was in the Elks Plot of the Tonopah Cemetery.

Sartin was born November 5, 1879, at Fleetwood, OK. His early life was spent in the southwest and during his youth he traveled extensively as a member of a professional baseball team, Several years ago he moved to Nevada and first established residence in Las Vegas, later moving to Tonopah. He had been a member of the Tonopah Lodge of Elks for six years."
